On Tuesday evening, the Search Committee recommended to Council, Pastor Gregg Lawson for consideration for a call from the congregation of Williamsburg CRC. Council approved this recommendation. On May 5, the congregation will vote after the morning worship service whether to call Pastor Gregg Lawson as a minister of the Word and Sacrament in our congregation. Signed proxy votes will be accepted and if 75% of the votes are in favour, a call will be extended to him. In your mailboxes you will find a summary of the discussion which was held with him and his wife Monday, April 8. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to call a member of the Search Committee or a member of council.

The Spring Congregational Meeting will be held on Thursday, April 25, starting at 7:30 with council members serving coffee and refreshments before the meeting. The meeting includes the approval of the financial statements for 2018 and a report from the FAC about projects completed during the past year and projects planned in the near future. It also includes a presentation by a member of Teen Challenge about their plans to open up a shelter/workshop in Ottawa. There will also be opportunity to speak to this representative before or after the meeting. Please pick up your agenda etc. in your church mailbox.

NOMINATIONS/AFFIRMATION

VOTES/CASTING LOTS: Council met again on Tuesday, April 16, and prayerfully considered the list of nominees to be presented to the congregation to fill the offices of deacon and elder in our church. Council thanks the congregation for their nominations and presents the following names to the congregation for a vote of affirmation: for elder—Andrew De Jong, Eric Don, Chris Johnson, John Menkhorst, Derrick Noort, Stuart Staal and Neil VanderMeer and for deacon---Andrew De Jong, Eric Don, John Menkhorst, Anjo Norg and Stuart Staal. Some have been nominated for both positions but will only serve in one position. Council deems these men to have the gifts to serve in this church and trusts that by the process of the affirmation vote and the casting of lots, the men of God's choosing will be selected.

On Sunday, May 5, after the worship service, the affirmation vote will be held. All confessing members are encouraged to vote and choose all those who they deem gifted for these positions. For those who are unable to attend proxy votes can be given or emailed to the clerk. From all those receiving affirmation from 50% or more of the votes from the congregation the lot will be cast. On Sunday, May 12, the lot will be cast and first 2 deacons will be chosen and then 3 elders will be chosen. We trust that our faithful God will bless our congregation through this process and will also bless those who are chosen to serve and those who are not chosen at this time.

TREASURER NEEDED: Being the treasurer of our church involves tasks such as collecting invoices and entering them into a computerized accounting system, maintaining paper copies in an organized system, keeping accounts payable current, looking after payroll and submitting monthly payroll deductions, preparing statements of income and expenses and attending FAC meetings to keep the committee members current on the church's financial affairs. If God has given you the gifts applicable to this position, please consider if you could fill this position.

Council will consider separating into two positions to lighten the load; bookkeeper to handle the daily entries and treasurer to handle the payroll, etc. The Tot's and Tea Group is looking for two additional babysitters to help watch the little ones as the mothers gather for bible study. One babysitter is needed for 1 Wednesday morning each month and the other babysitter is needed for 1 Thursday morning every couple of months.
