Students Engaging in Summer Ministries



Silvio Esteves—Williamsburg, Ontario

During my past summer internship, I was able to work at the Christian Reformed Church in Williamsburg, a small rural town of northeast Ontario. This church was organized in 1952, mostly by Dutch immigrant families, and even planted, in 1989, another church in the municipality of South Dundas of which Williamsburg is part. Williamsburg CRC is a

beautiful church with a heartened community.

In so many ways I felt blessed to be part of that church. This was my very first pastoral experience, and it could not have been a better one. For ten weeks, not only did they welcome me into their home and at their table, they also trusted me with their worship service and visitations.

Canadians are famous worldwide for their politeness and civility. According to the World Happiness Report of 2017, the Netherlands and Canada occupy respectively the 6th and 7th places as one of the happiest countries in the world. A big component when considering levels of happiness among nations is the level of trust among its citizens and government.

In that way, I was more than blessed by this Dutch rooted community in Canada. Being foreign-born, I know it takes a lot of courage to welcome a student-minister from a different tradition, from another country, and with an accent they were not used to, and to trust that person with the spiritual teach-ings of the church. But that is what they did, with the utmost compassion and courtesy.

All throughout the Bible, there are teachings about welcoming the stranger or the immigrant. Williamsburg CRC showed me that they are living up to this Christian teaching. They demonstrate in loving ways, in each smile, in each con-versation, that Christianity is an intrinsic and daily part of their lives.

May God keep and bless them!
