July 29 - World Renew - Maternal and Child

Health is an important part of the community development work in most of the countries they work in. Many women who live in poverty have no information and lack the freedom to make decisions about their own and their children's health. Hundreds of thousands of women die during pregnancy or childbirth every year, and nearly nine million children die before reaching the age of five. Many of these deaths can be prevented through community-based health promotion, education and nutrition programs.

August 5 - Education Assitance Fund This fund provides financial support to families who send their children to Christian elementary or Christian high school.

August 12 - Benevolent Fund

This fund is used by the deacons to financially assist those within our church and the community when a need arises or help is requested.
