June 3 - Timothy Christian School F.A.C.E.

FACE is a fund that is set aside to help those who desire to send their children to TCS, but find themselves short of having enough to cover the full cost of Christian Education. For more information talk to one of the Deacons.

June 10 - Citizens for Public Justice

Citizens for public justice's mission is to promote public justice in Canada by shaping key public





policy debates through research and analysis, publishing and public dialogue. They encourage citizens, leaders in society and governments to support policies and practices which reflect God's call for love, justice and stewardship.

June 17 - Christian Horizons is a non-profit, faith-based charitable organization serving nearly 1,500 Ontario families. With more than 200 residences as well as respite care homes and retreat facilities, they offer programs and services to minister to people with special needs. They are dedicated to see those with special needs live out the fullest of lives. Spiritual life is an important part of this ministry.

June 24 - Community FoodShare (formerly Dundas County Food Bank) is a registered charity created to help fight hunger in our community. Community Food Share operates from two locations which are open three times a week and a food cupboard open one day a week. We serve over 350 families, representing more than 1,000 people, 40% of whom are children. Our programs are supported through generous donations from individuals, businesses, churches and service organizations in the community.

Voting for deacon: The voting for a new deacon on Sunday, May 27, resulted in a tie. Our church's policy states, "When a tie occurs between two candidates, only one of whom can be chosen, another vote is to be taken between these two candidates. If the result is again a tie, a lot shall be cast." The congregation is asked to vote again for one deacon, between Josh Geertsema and Andrew Harbers, on Sunday, June 10, after the worship service. Proxy votes can be given to Jack Van Gilst or placed in his mailbox up to the time of the vote.
