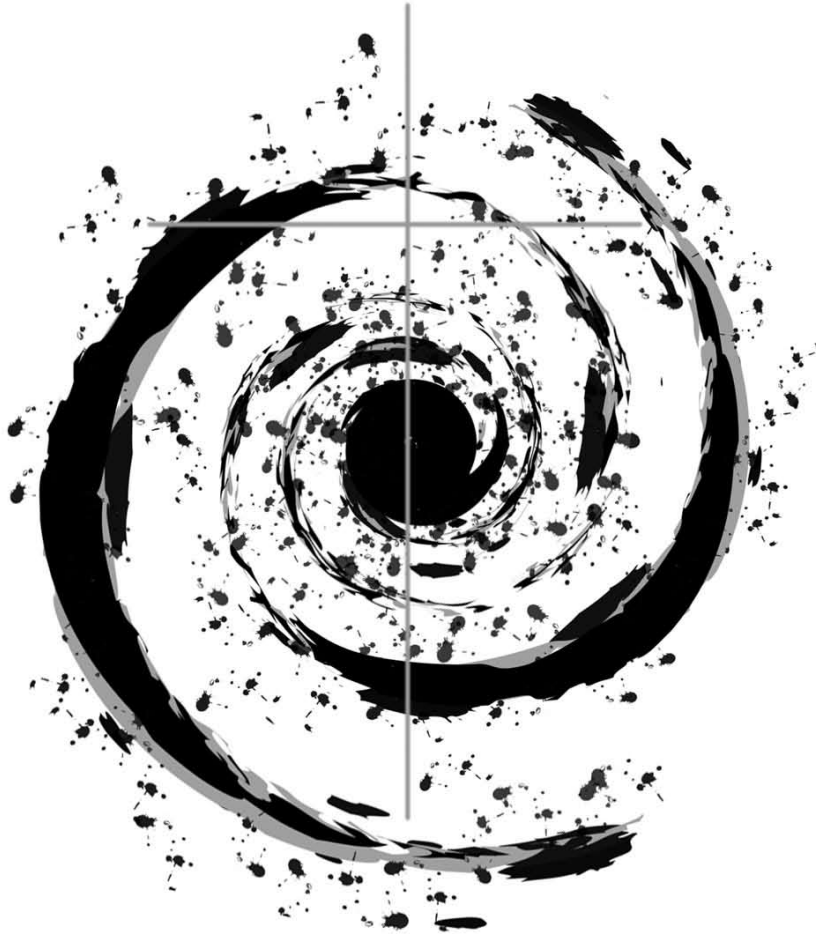

September Verse of the Month

We'll be learning the first Q&A of the Catechism since it naturally coincides with the sermon series.

Q. What is your only comfort in life and in death?

A. That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.

He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.

The Campus Inklings Lectures: "CS Lewis and the Gift of Failure" & "The Oxford Inklings for a New Generation" - Dr. Mark Scott - Monday September 23 and Tuesday, September 24 at 7:30pm.

The Monday evening lecture will be in the basement of the Royal Oak Pub at 161 Laurier Ave. The Tuesday lecture will take place on campus at the University of Ottawa in Lamoureux room 221. The Inklings were a group of literary scholars and friends who met regularly to share their writings in Oxford around the Second World War. It featured C. S. Lewis and J. R. R. Tolkien, who read selections of works that would become classics, including *The Problem of Pain* and *The Lord of the Rings*. The second campus lecture will detail the origin, structure, purpose, and legacy of the Inklings. How might the Inklings inspire a new generation of authors and thinkers. Dr. Mark S. M. Scott is Associate Professor and Chair of the Department of Religious Studies at Thorneloe University. Campus Inklings is sponsored by the Ottawa Christian Reformed Campus Chaplaincy.
