
Offering Schedule

Council news: Council met on Tuesday evening and chose the officers and committee reps and the new members signed the "Covenant for Office-bearers". Jack Menkhorst remains as chairman and Ype VanderVeen remains as vice-chairman. Jack Van Gilst has agreed to become the stated clerk of council. He will prepare the agenda for council and prepare and distribute the minutes. The committee reps are: FAC--Neil VanderMeer; Community Service Committee--John Menkhorst; Education Committee--Jason Wagensveld; Worship Committee--Andrew Harbers. The APT (Abuse Prevention Team) will now be called the Safe Church Committee and Harold Douma is the rep. The elder and deacon districts have not yet been assigned. Transition to our new pastor, Pastor Gregg Lawson: Members of the Search Committee and of council have been in regular communication with Pastor Gregg and Laurie Lawson since he accepted the call to become our next lead pastor. It is important for him, as it would be for any new pastor, to establish relationships with the members and leaders of the new congregation. For that reason, Council has approved a schedule so that Pastor Gregg has sufficient time to visit, share and pray with members of the congregation during the summer, something he and Laurie are looking forward to. During the month of July Pastor Gregg will transition from his ministry in Bloomfield to Williamsburg, which involves moving into their new home in Williamsburg. He will begin employment by our congregation on July 23 and the following is a schedule of events planned for his first six weeks:

- --Friday evening, July 26—Installation service with representatives from classis and local churches invited, which is preceded by a BBQ that's open to everyone.
- --Sunday, July 28—Pastor Gregg leads first worship service at Williamsburg CRC
- --Sunday, August 11 -- Pastor Gregg leads worship service
- --Sunday, August 25-Pastor Gregg leads worship service
- --Sunday, September 8—Pastor Gregg leads worship service to begin new season of ministry
- --Friday evening, September 13—Social evening for members of council, search committee and their spouses and Pastor Gregg and Laurie.

This schedule will give Pastor Gregg the opportunity to connect with members of the congregation rather than spending many hours in his study writing sermons. It is the prayer of council that this process will help to build a strong pastor-congregation relationship from the beginning of his ministry.
