June 30 Community Food Share (formerly Dundas County Food Bank) is a registered charity created to help fight hunger in our community. Community Food Share operates from two locations which are open three times a week and a food cupboard open one day a week. We serve over 350 families, representing more than 1,000 people, 40% of whom are children. Our programs are supported through generous donations from individuals, businesses, churches and service organizations in the community.

July 7 Open Doors Open Doors' vision is three-fold. First, their vision is to strengthen and equip the Body of Christ living under or facing restriction and persecution because of their faith in Jesus Christ, and to encourage their involvement in world evangelism by providing Bibles and literature, media, leadership training, socio-economic development and intercessory prayer. Second, it is their aim to prepare the Body of Christ living in threatened or unstable areas to face persecution and suffering. Third, their goal is to educate and mobilize the Body of Christ living in the free world to identify with threatened and persecuted Christians and to be actively involved in assisting them.

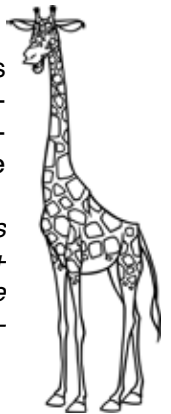
VBS Painting Night! We need some eager people to help paint and get the decorations ready for ROAR VBS, which is just a week away! No special talents necessary, just willingness of heart!
