October 14 - Benevolent Fund - This fund is used by the deacons to financially assist those within our church and the community when a need arises or help is requested.

October 21 - Christian Blind Mission - Christian Blind Mission (CBM) works to rescue and restore people trapped in poverty by disability, regardless of race, age, gender or religion. Founded in 1908, Christian Blind Mission helps over 36 million sick and disabled people each year at more than 750 projects in over 80 of the world's poorer countries. Since its beginning in 1978, CBM Canada has endeavoured to make Canadians aware of the needs of people who are disabled or at risk of disability in developing countries.

October 28 - Resonate Goba Ministries - Formed by the joining of Christian Reformed Home Missions and Christian Reformed World Missions, Resonate Global Mission, trains mis-
