The following are some highlights from the two June council meetings:

- 1. Pastor Syl was welcomed to the meeting of council and was given the opportunity to report on some of the visits he had made with members of the congregation. Pastor Joe meets with Pastor Syl on a weekly basis to discuss ministry. Andrew Van Veen and Derrick Noort also meet with him informally and will be asking some members of the congregation to help evaluate a few of his sermons.

- 4. The new executive was chosen: Chairman—Jack Menkhorst; Vicechair—Ype VanderVeen; Jack Van Gilst will serve as clerk until a new stated clerk is found.
- 5. Andrew Harbers will serve as council rep on the Worship Committee;
 Jason Wagonsveld will serve as council rep on the Education Committee;
 Mark Geertsema will serve as council rep on the Abuse Prevention
 Team; John Guthrie will serve as council rep on the Community Service
 Committee; Mike Dewar will serve as council rep on FAC.
- 6. Jason Wagensveld will continue to serve as youth elder; Harold De Jong will continue to serve as elder to the elderly; Harold Douma will be the

elder in district 2; Ype VanderVeen in district 4 and Dan Schuler in district 6.
